

# Learning Literacy: What you will see in the classroom

- Develop a life long love and enjoyment of literacy in all of its forms.
- Students involved each day in speaking, listening, reading, writing, viewing, and presenting
- Students involved in literacy learning will be imbedded and enhanced across the curriculum.
- The literacy programme will be enriched throughout the integrated curriculum
- Individual needs of the students being met through deliberate acts of teaching.
- Students will know and share their learning intentions and next steps in learning.
- Students reflecting on their learning through self, peer and group reflection.
- Feedback and feedforward to inform next steps in student learning.
- Language processes, strategies and structure being taught explicitly embedded the integrated curriculum
- Students involved in a variety of 1-1, small group and whole class discussions.
- Rich oral language and questioning embedded in literacy programme.
- Creativity and critical thinking being encouraged.
- Making real connections between what is being learnt and the use of skills.
- Students' lives and culture are reflected in their literacy tasks.
- Students selecting texts for personal enjoyment
- Students use their skills to engage with tasks and texts that are increasingly sophisticated and challenging, and they do this in increasing depth
- Students increasingly independently reworking their learning
- Digital tools will be used in literacy
- Use of literacy Taonga (treasure)
- Celebration of literacy progress in the school
